School nurses cannot administer prescription or nonprescription drugs to a student without the following:

1. Written directions from the prescribing physician regarding the administration of the medication.
2. Written permission from the parent for the school nurse to administer the medication.

This form should be completed by physician and parent. The physician may choose to use his/her own letterhead, but the basic information must be provided. Parental permission and physician's directions must be received before any medication will be administered in school.

Medication should be in the original container with the child's name. All medication turned over to the school is kept under lock and key. Students will not carry medication with them, at any time, unless written authorization is received from the physician. Our preference is for all medication to be kept in the Health Office.
